His books include 'Jewels and Ashes', 'The Fig Tree', 'Café Scheherazade', and, most recently, 'Scraps of Heaven', set in the immigrant community of post-war Carlton.

He is the author of numerous stories, columns and essays, and co-writer of the play, 'Kan Yama Kan', in which refugees tell their stories. Zable has been a visiting lecturer at Deakin, Melbourne, Monash, RMIT, La Trobe and Victoria Universities. He is the president of International PEN, Melbourne and holds a doctorate from the School of Creative Arts, Melbourne University.
