Denis Tracey is Deputy Director of the Asia-Pacific Centre for Philanthropy and Social Investment at the Faculty of Business and Enterprise at the Swinburne University of Technology. This centre provides education, research, advice and consultancy services for private and corporate grantmakers and social investors. It also offers Australia's first postgraduate training in grantmaking.

Most of Denis Tracey's work in the past ten years has been in the not-for-profit sector. In the past five years he has published two books; *Family Business*; the *Volatile Mix of Love, Power and Money and Giving it Away*; *In Praise of Philanthropy*.

This series of lectures follows on from the "Going Beyond The Bottom Line" initiative launched at the lofC conference in Melbourne, in January 2007 and is part of the Caux Initiatives for Business program running in Europe and India.
