Biodata

Tunku Abdul Aziz Ibrahim was Special Adviser to the Secretary General of the United Nations (UN) from 2006 to 2007. Based in New York, he set up the UN Ethics Office during his tenure.

Tunku Aziz founded the Malaysian Chapter of Transparency International, the global coalition against corruption. Now called the Malaysian Society for Transparency & Integrity, he was its President until December 2004. From 1998 to 2002, Tunku Aziz served as Vice-Chairman of the Board of Directors of Transparency International. In 2004, he published a book, *Fighting Corruption: My Mission*.

Tunku Aziz has held senior management positions in large private and public sector organisations in Malaysia, Hong Kong and the UK. These include Guthrie Corporation, the Central Bank of Malaysia, Sime Darby and the Commonwealth Secretariat. He has also been involved with the World Bank, the International Institute on Public Ethics, and national and regional chambers of commerce and industry.

Tunku Aziz currently contributes a weekly column in the *New Straits Times*.

Synopsis of Talk

Accountability is the cornerstone of democratic values and principles; the antithesis of irresponsible and corrupt governance. Nation building demands high standards of accountability from the leadership and all those who have responsibility for the well-being and welfare of those under their care. Transparency is the mother of accountability and cannot exist in a closed and secretive environment.
