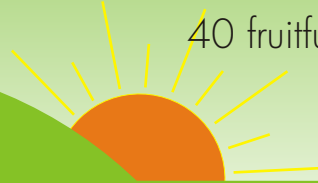


# Re-investing in the future

All are warmly invited. Especially those who have:

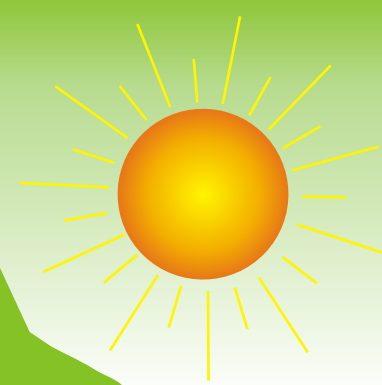
- ◆ contributed to make Asia Plateau what it is

## Programme Outline:

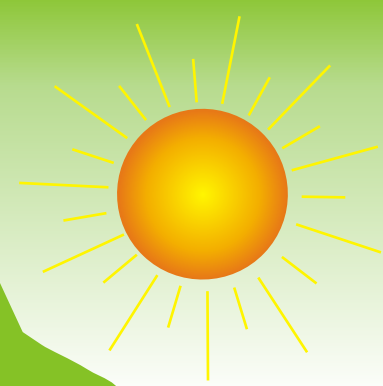
**15 January:** Opening session at 4.30 pm (please arrive in time to register and find your room).
