Program

What does it take to build trust across divides of culture, race and politics? Do our lives demonstrate the kind of change that we want to see in the world? What tools do we need as peacemakers?

Tools for Change offers six days of personal development and skills building for people of all sectors of society. Participants are given an opportunity to examine the core values of Initiatives of Change and their relationship to peacemaking and community building. The cultural diversity of the conference allows an exchange of ideas about different ways to solve problems. The programme will equip and empower participants for the work they will undertake when they leave Caux and will set them on a path of further discovery.

An international faculty will address theory and practice around creating and sustaining positive change. Every activity, including service in the house, will contribute to the development of participants in a unified, interactive learning experience.

Learning Tracks

In addition to the shared learning experience, participants will select from a variety of courses offered in these parallel learning tracks:

- Peace building: Conflict, Trauma, and History
- Honest Conversation and Dialogue Facilitation
- Mobilizing and Maintaining Networks for Action
- Communicating a Vision, Telling the Story
- Inner Resources for Change
