The Annual Lecture

The lecture accompanying the awards ceremony is a thought-provoking keynote address by a high-profile speaker in the field of trustbuilding, peacebuilding or social change.

In 2024, the Annual lecture was given by Professor Rajmohan Gandhi — a historian, journalist, former MP and grandson of Mahatma Gandhi. A moderated Q&A session follows, allowing attendees to engage with the speaker and explore key themes in greater depth.

Musical or artistic performances are part of the event, highlighting cultural themes of unity and reconciliation. The event concludes with a networking session, allowing attendees to connect and collaborate on future trustbuilding initiatives.

The Awards

The inaugural Awards ceremony took place in Caux, Switzerland in 2023. The second Awards ceremony and Lecture was hosted in September 2024 with a global audience who gathered in person in Richmond, Virginia, United States.

Award Categories

We are proud to offer three prestigious awards:

1. Trustbuilder of the Year, celebrates exceptional impact by an organization or individual that demonstrates excellent leadership through their vision in the pursuit of building trust.

2. Young Trustbuilder of the Year, honors individuals under 30 years of age who are driving innovative trustbuilding initiatives and have inspired other young people in the work of trustbuilding.

3. Lifetime Achiever, recognizes individuals who have dedicated their lives to building trust and reconciliation, displaying exceptional leadership, depth of service and a willingness to adapt and evolve over time within the trustbuilding field.
