The Initiative Central- and Eastern Europe invites young people between the ages of 18 and 25 to the international seminar „Make a Change! European Youth in Dialogue”.

Participants have to come from one of the countries, where the initiative is active: Ukraine, Poland, Belarus, Romania and Germany, and should have advanced knowledge of the English language.

The week-long seminar in Ukraine gives an opportunity for young people to reflect upon questions of active and European citizenship, to look at and experience the models of participation and to develop strategies to actively influence social change in their environment. Beyond intercultural encounters, the seminar also offers practical life-skills training, such as development of self-confidence, self-understanding and societal insights.



COURSE OFFERS:

- practical life skills training on how to be a change-maker;
- understanding how people grow and change;
- understanding of different intercultural aspects - how to value your own culture and background and to be open for accepting other cultures;
- how to find the motivation to develop and sustain democratic culture.
- How to become an inwardly free person in order to initiate and lead changing process

WHO CAN APPLY AND HOW TO APPLY?

The seminar is open to all young people between the ages of 18 and 25 from Ukraine, Poland, Belarus, Romania and Germany. You must have strong proficiency in English as the entire seminar will be conducted in English. Participants should be active in an NGO of the Network Initiative of Central and Eastern Europe and interested to reflect and to develop their engagement.

Afterwards, we will select 4 applicants from each country who we feel are the best fit, so, please, make sure you tell us a lot about yourself.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The seminar will be held in Koktebel, Crimea, Ukraine from October 13 th to 20th. You will be accommodated in a wonderful resort area in a private hotel, sharing rooms with 2-3 course participants from other countries, thus experiencing living in intercultural environment right there. Organizers cover all costs of accommodation and food. We refund 70% of travel costs up to 280€ (GER, PL) or 140€ (BY, RO) to Crimea. There is no participation fee, however a financial contribution towards the cultural program from each participant would be highly appreciated (approximately 20€).
