### CONTEXT

Today's social, political, economic and environmental crises demonstrate humanity's interdependence and the need for global cooperation on a new scale. Yet, many of us are unwilling to change our living and thinking, determined to hang on to the illusion of independence and self-sufficiency. This conference aims to provide a space for concerned youths from Asia Pacific region and beyond to have honest and sincere dialogues with themselves and with each other on how individuals can identify their roles in and take personal responsibilities for major issues of our world today and find specific steps that they can take to stop being part of the problem and start living the answer.
